<b>Diluvio Albarino, Rias Baixas 2017 - SPAIN</b> From wet and windy Galicia, fresh white flowers on the nose and rich and persistent on the palate. Goes really well with seafood

<b>Hartenberg Riesling, Stellenbosch 2015 - SOUTH AFRICA</b> Spicy on the nose but gives way to a floral and fruity rich taste, pairs well with a variety of foods.	29.50			
<b>Rioja Blanco Otoman, Sierra Cantabria 2016 - SPAIN</b> Wonderful on the nose with fresh citrus fruits, and a palate of apricots and hints of vanilla	34.50			
<b>Ataraxia Chardonnay, Hemel-en-Aarde 2016 - SOUTH AFRICA</b> Consistently regarded as one of the greatest white wines made in South Africa, unashamedly Old World in style, this is a marvellously focused wine that effortlessly manages to be both subtle and intense.	45.00			
<b>Chateau Montelena, Potter Valley Riesling, Napa Valley, California 2016 - USA</b> One of the foremost estates in the Napa Valley. It shot to fame in 1976 with the famous Judgement of Paris tasting (the events later dramatized in the film 'Bottle Shock') when it won first place for its 1973 Napa valley Chardonnay. Bright, clear, pale gold in colour, this exceptional Riesling opens with rich peach and cut apple aromas, Lychee and rose high tones. Simply sensational.	49.50
